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Steps to submit the Fellows Application packet:

Be a student enrolled at a college or university in Alaska, Hawaii, Montana, New Mexico, Nevada, or Wyoming who will be graduating on or after December 2019. Students graduating in May or August 2019 will not be eligible in 2019.

1. Choose one or more Mentors from the school(s) you are applying to.
2. Complete the Fellows application form.
3. Assemble and submit the application packet. Packet must include an application form and a copy of your most current transcript (unofficial is acceptable).
4. **Identify 2 references and invite them to submit their references using the 'Register References' tab in the left hand column** - references from science faculty/instructors are preferred. This tab is available as soon as you begin your application so invite your references early! References are due on January 31, 2019.

The Idaho INBRE Fellowship program is a competitive program. The number of applications we receive will exceed the available Fellowships. In order to be considered for a Fellowship we must receive your completed application packet, letters of reference, by the due date of January 31, 2019. We cannot consider incomplete packets.
