

INBRE-5 Use Your Summer to Complete Your Manuscript- FOA

INBRE will provide funding to complete and submit INBRE-related peer-reviewed manuscripts.

Eligibility: Faculty at the following institutions are eligible: Brigham Young University-Idaho, College of Eastern Idaho, College of Idaho, College of Southern Idaho, College of Western Idaho, Lewis-Clark State College, North Idaho College, Northwest Nazarene University.

Start/end date: *May 15, 2025 through August 15, 2025. *Dependent upon annual INBRE funding.

Deadline for manuscript: You are required to submit a manuscript to a peer-reviewed journal on or before August 15, 2025.

Eligible institutions include: Brigham Young University – Idaho, The College of Idaho, College of Eastern Idaho, College of Western Idaho, College of Southern Idaho, Lewis-Clark State College, North Idaho College, and Northwest Nazarene University.

You may not accept this award if you receive a Developmental Research Project or Pilot Project
The funding will be an amendment to the institutional INBRE subcontract. You will be required to track your budget internally.

- Please note:
 - Earliest start date is May 15, 2025
 - This opportunity is for one summer session only.
 - A budget, limited to 1.5 months of effort (including associated fringe & indirects) for the faculty member writing the manuscript.
 - o No research effort may be funded via this award.
 - Due date for applications is February 1st, 2025, 11:59 pm PDT. Updated to Rolling Deadline

Application Requirements:

Writing Timeline: Submit a document addressing following three sections: 1) What is completed so far? (may include: data collected, written sections, completed figures, etc.) Provide supporting evidence such as a draft or data set. 2) Timeline for completion of manuscript. (describe what needs completed with weekly goals). 3) Journal choice (include names of potential journal(s) that you will submit to.

Priority will be given to applicants who can show Tables & Figures with concrete data. Other tangible 'prework' may be submitted to demonstrate already established progress. Upload document(s) here.

- 1. Mid-way through your writing effort, you will meet via Zoom with Drs. Scott Minnich and Carolyn Bohach to go over working sections.
- 2. You must submit your manuscript to Drs. Minnich and Bohach prior to submitting to the journal.
- 3. Costs for publication from reputable journals will be covered by INBRE. Please communicate with Whitney Myers (whitneym@uidaho.edu) when this information is finalized.
- 4. You will be asked to cite INBRE in your publication and submit annual reporting to the Idaho INBRE Program. The INBRE Evaluator, Ashley Bogar, will reach out to you for this requirement.
