Eligibility

- **Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0** with emphasis on grades in the sciences; GPAs of 3.3 and above are most competitive
- **Minimum prerequisites include:**
 - Chemistry** - Minimum of 16 semester/24 quarter credits which must include an upper division organic chemistry and/or biochemistry course
 - Biological Sciences** - Minimum of 16 semester/24 quarter credits which must include general microbiology, immunology and medical microbiology (or pathogenic bacteriology)
 - Math** - Statistics
- **Preferred Courses:** human anatomy and human physiology
- **Encouraged Courses:** hematology, clinical chemistry, molecular biology, genetics, quantitative analysis, clinical diagnosis, cell biology, medical terminology, microbial physiology, mycology, parasitology, virology, antimicrobial therapy, and epidemiology
